- Hershey Park: Sun. July 12<sup>th</sup>
- Outer Banks: Tues/Weds., July 14<sup>th</sup> -15<sup>th</sup>
  - Includes Wright Brothers Memorial, Jockey’s Ridge State Park, Roanoke Island, Fort Raleigh Historic Site, Maritime Museum, Lighthouse. Ranger programs, exploring, swimming, kite flying.
- Philadelphia: Friday July 17<sup>th</sup>
  - Includes Independence Hall, Liberty Bell, Reading Terminal Market, Philadelphia Zoo.
- Camping at Gifford Pinchot State Park (PA), Oregon Inlet National Park (NC), Musser Scout Reservation (PA).
  - In-camp meals provided
- Travel Days: Sat, 7/11, Mon. 7/13, Thurs. 7/16, Sat. 7/18
  - Scouts responsible for on-the-road meals (fast food)

*Many areas we’re visiting have gift shops, snack sales, fast food, and other options to separate scouts and their cash. All are tourist areas with higher food rates than local areas. Please have a discussion with your scout about responsible spending, and set an amount of cash for him to bring on the trip. ## 2026 Hershey – Outer Banks Trip

### Itinerary

- Sat. 7/11 Depart Hooksett approx. 10am, drive to Gifford Pinchot State Park in Lewisberry, PA; set up camp & cook dinner.
- Sun. 7/12 Cook breakfast, drive to Hershey Park, spend the day. Eat lunch & dinner at the park, come back in the evening.
- Mon. 7/13 Breakfast, then pack up and drive to Oregon Inlet National Park Campground, Nags Head, N. Carolina. Lunch on the road; set up, dinner in camp.
- Tues. 7/14 Breakfast, make bag lunch. Go to Wright Brothers National Memorial. Explore the site; Ranger Program (Wind and Sand) at 11am.  
Go to Jockey's Ridge State Park. Eat bag picnic lunch. Explore area. Possible kite flying, swimming in Roanoke Sound.  
Head back to campground for dinner.
- Weds. 7/15 Breakfast, make bag lunch. Go to Roanoke Island; visit Fort Raleigh National Historic Site. Explore area; Ranger Program (The Lost Colony – Walking Tour) at 11am.  
Visit the Roanoke Island Maritime Museum and Roanoke Marshes Lighthouse.  
Eat bag picnic lunch somewhere in Manteo.  
Afternoon options: Visit Roanoke Island Festival Park (Elizabeth II sailing ship, Indian Town, Settlement Site); OR find surf-side swimming and/or kite flying.  
Return to camp for dinner.
- Thurs. 7/16 Breakfast; pack up and drive to Musser Scout Reservation, Marlborough, PA.  
Lunch on the road. Set up camp; dinner in camp.
- Fri. 7/17 Breakfast. Drive to Lansdale, take train to downtown Philadelphia. Go to Independence Hall & Liberty Bell.  
Walk to Reading Terminal Market for lunch.  
Take bus to Philadelphia Zoo. Look at the animals. Don't touch.  
Take bus back downtown, train to Lansdale, drive back to camp. Dinner in camp.
- Sat. 7/18 Breakfast. Pack up, drive to Hooksett. Shower. Shower again.
