Campership Info (Summer Camp Scholarships)

There are a variety of financial aid sources available to help get your scout to summer camp. The most important thing to remember is that the troop will make sure that any scout who wants to can go to camp; you just need to let us know that you need our help.

- **Council Scholarships:** There's an online application at <https://nhscouting.org/scholarships/> (scroll down to "Request for Summer Camp Scholarship"). **This application needs to be completed no later than March 12th!** For the unit leader section, my email is fedcompsrv@comcast.net and my phone is (603) 848-2086. These scholarships, if approved, will only cover up to 50% of the early bird rate, and you'll still need to pay your \$100 deposit by Mar. 12th to hold that rate.
- **Troop 292 rotating loan fund:** The troop has received an anonymous donation to establish a rotating loan fund to help scouts pay for camp, registration, etc. Scouts can borrow from this fund to cover fees, then pay it back when they're able to. To request funds, email either [Mr. Scott](#) or [Mr. Perrotta](#) with your request.
- **Troop 292 Camperships:** We include several hundred dollars in our annual budget to cover campership requests, and have also had an anonymous contribution into this fund. This is a straight grant, no repayment expected. Similar to the loan fund, requests should be emailed to either [Mr. Scott](#) or [Mr. Perrotta](#).
- **Scout Accounts and Fundraising:** Scouts earn a portion of troop fundraising income into scout accounts to be used for summer camp, trips, dues, etc. You can check your scout's account balance [here](#); if you want to apply any or all of that amount to camp, email [Mr. Scott](#) or [Mr. Perrotta](#). Your scout also has another opportunity to raise funds for camp with the Scout Card fundraiser launching this spring.
